

Christmas Pocket Stocking

Materials

- Two pieces of plain white paper or construction paper
- Hole Punch
- Ribbon or yarn
 OR
- Stapler/Tape/Glue
- Collage Material:
 String, tissue paper, tin foil, wrapping paper, stickers, scrap paper
- Markers or pencils
- Scissors



Process

Stack two pieces of paper and use a pencil or marker to draw an outline of a stocking. Make sure the top of the stocking is big enough to hold a holiday card. Cut out the stocking and choose how you want to bind it.

Stitch Method: Use a hole punch to make a line of evenly spaced holes around your stocking. Leave the top of the stocking without holes to leave that open to

hold cards. Use a long piece of ribbon or string and sew the edges together. You can go up and down or wrap it around the edge.

Staple or Tape or Glue Method: You can put your pieces together with whatever you have available. You can staple around the edge, or tape the two pieces around the edge, or even glue the edge by running a small amount of glue around the edge between the two pieces. Just remember to leave the top open!
